- Vehicles that are not registered, cannot be parked on your property. Unsightly Premises, Bylaw 688, Section (n) 2
- Recreational Vehicles are NOT to be parked on Lougheed roads. Traffic Control Bylaw 692, Section 9.9

Routine Fall Maintenance

The sun is still shining and the weather is still warm, but the season has changed once again and it is fall. With the autumn season, there are a few routine home maintenance items you should take care of before winter comes.

- If you use a wood burning fireplace, get your chimney cleaned and inspected.
- Take a look up on your roof for broken/missing shingles and repair as necessary.
- Clean your eaves. Special tools are available so you can stay on the ground and still clean your gutters.
- Replace any worn weather stripping around your doors and windows.
- Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. Replace the batteries and clean the covers to ensure they will function properly.
- Replace your furnace filter.
- Check for water leaks around your hot water tank, toilets and under sinks. Early leak detection and repair can avoid costly repairs in the future.
